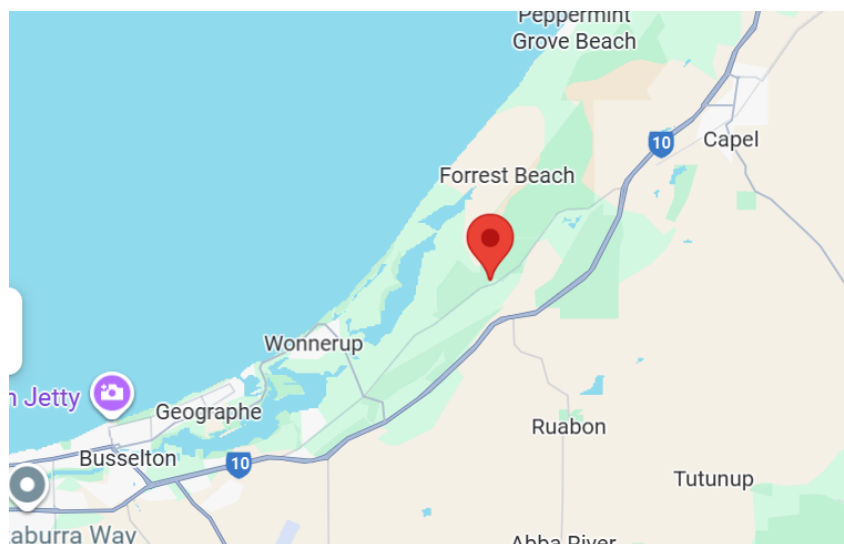


## Committee Member Background Information Sheet

The Ludlow Tuart Forest Restoration Group (LTFRG) is a community group of approximately 700 members primarily located in the southwest of Western Australia (WA), who are dedicated to preserving the rich environmental, cultural and social heritage of the Ludlow Tuart Forest. Since 2018, our members have planted over 125,000 Tuart trees, saved the heritage listed Ludlow Settlement from ruin, restored several historic buildings and have opened the area to visitors through our Resource Centre, opening of the Ludlow Community Café and the hosting of regular community events.

## Lease

The LTRFG has a 20+20 lease agreement with DBCA. The lease area is approximately 50 hectares and includes the Ludlow Settlement plus a small area of adjacent forest.

### Volunteering

The principal volunteering day is Wednesday morning every week. Starting and finishing time is flexible. There are two main groups:

Some volunteers work at least three days a week caring for plants and keeping restoration on track.
