Terms and Conditions

2 February 2026 rev3

1. GENERAL

- By entering the prize, the artist agrees to these binding terms and conditions. These terms and conditions together with the artist's completed entry form, will form the agreement between the artist and the Ludlow Tuart Forest Restoration Group Inc.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- The competition is open to all artists **worldwide**.
- If under the age of 18, a Parent/Legal Guardian consent form must be provided with the entry submission.
- Members of the Ludlow Tuart Forest Restoration Group committee and the One Tree Prize sub-committee can enter the competition but are not eligible to win first prize.
- Entries are limited to one per person.

3. ARTWORK REQUIREMENTS

General

- All artworks must be the original work of the artist and not infringe the copyright, moral rights, or other rights of any third party.
- All artworks submitted cannot be completed in whole or part by artificial intelligence (AI).
- The artwork must not have been awarded a prize in any other competition.
- The Ludlow Tuart Forest Restoration Group reserves the right to not display any artwork where, in its discretion, considers that it may be unlawful, offensive, defamatory, or unsafe.

Criteria

- **The painting must be of an existing tree, anywhere in the world, confirmed by GPS coordinates.**
- **The artwork must be a painting on 8-inch x 8-inch stretched canvas supplied by the One Tree Art Prize committee.**
- **Entries not adhering to the criteria will be considered ineligible.**
- **The artwork will be judged anonymously. Please do not sign the front of the painting.**

4. ARTWORK SUBMISSION

- Entry details cannot be changed after the closing date.
- Artists (and their agents) must agree not to display any images of the artwork(s) on any social media platforms prior to the announcement of the winner.
- Artists whose work are selected for the exhibition must allow their work to be reproduced for promotional, review and educational purposes.

5. NO PRE-SELECTION PROCESS

- There is exhibition space for all submitted paintings.



6. PREPARATION FOR DELIVERY

- All selected artworks must be framed on a stretched canvas to our specifications with D-rings to be placed at the back of the work one third from the top of the frame.
- The painting must be delivered in suitable packaging for temporary storage prior to, and after the exhibition.
- The artwork must be clearly marked on the back with the artists name, phone number and title of work.
- Wet paintings will not be accepted.

7. DELIVERY OF ARTWORKS

- There is no pre-selection process. All paintings will be exhibited at the Ludlow Art Gallery.
- The Ludlow Tuart Forest Group will not pay for any costs incurred in the delivery and return of any entry.

8. PRIZES

- The art prize committee will review all entries and select an artwork for first prize.
- First prize is acquisitional.
- Members of the Ludlow Tuart Forest Restoration Group cannot be judges.
- The Judge's decision will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- All prize money will be paid within 4 weeks of the award date.

9. SALE OF ARTWORKS

- Artwork submitted must be for sale.
- The first prize artwork is acquisitional. All other artwork will be sold for a fixed price of \$250.
- Unsold artworks can remain at the Ludlow Gallery and will be available for sale at the gallery and online for 12 months from exhibition close date.
- The Ludlow Tuart Forest Restoration Group inc. shall be entitled to and will retain 50% (GST inclusive) commission on all artworks sold during the exhibition period.
- If an artwork is sold, the artist may be required to supply the Ludlow Tuart Forest Restoration Group with a tax invoice to satisfy GST requirements. Artists registered for GST should quote their Australian Business Number (ABN) on their Tax Invoice. If registered for GST, the commission is levied on the sale price inclusive of GST. If the artist is unable to provide an ABN, the invoice must be accompanied by a 'Statement of Supplier' form available from the ATO.
- Artists will be notified of the sale of their artwork(s) by the conclusion of the exhibition.

10. INSURANCE

- The Ludlow Tuart Forest Restoration Group Inc. will exercise all reasonable care in handling artworks submitted but will not be responsible for loss or damage to any artwork whilst in our custody. We recommend artists insure their artwork against loss or damage during transit and whilst in our custody.

11. COLLECTION OF ARTWORKS

- Artists have the option to collect their artwork from the Ludlow Gallery at the end of the exhibition.
- If the person collecting the artwork is not the artist or purchaser, they must present written or signed permission to collect on the artist's behalf.

12. AMENDMENTS

- The Ludlow Tuart Forest Restoration Group Inc. may amend these terms and conditions and the entry form at any time, subject to giving notice to the artist via this webpage.
